



Garden After Dark – Costume Guidelines

Garden After Dark is a casual, family-oriented environment. Ensuring the event is family-friendly is an important part of the experience. In that spirit, we ask guests to use discretion and common sense when it comes to costumes. While we encourage creativity, we also value safety and good judgement. Please note the following guidelines.

General Guidelines:

- Red Butte Garden reserves the right to deny admission to or remove any person wearing attire the Garden, in its sole discretion, considers to be inappropriate or that could detract from the experience of other guests.
- Costumes must be family-friendly and may not be obstructive, offensive, objectionable, or violent.
- Costumes may not contain any weapons that resemble or could easily be mistaken for an actual weapon.
- Costumes may not contain sharp objects, pointed objects, or other materials that may accidentally strike another guest.
- Guests who do not adhere to these guidelines may be refused entry into or removed from the event, unless his or her costume/accessory can be modified to meet the above standards.

Additional Guidelines for guest ages 14 and older

- Headwear, including hats, may be worn as long as it does not cover your eyes.
- Full or partial costume masks that cover your eyes may not be worn.
- Full coverage face paint of any kind is not permitted.
