



Seed Germination



Botanists are scientists who study plants. Botanists use the word **germinate** to describe when a baby plant **sprouts** or wakes up and begins to grow.




What Seeds Need to Germinate

Draw three pictures showing how you think seeds get the air, water, and warmth they need to grow. Then, write one sentence describing what you drew.




